AMENDED SHORT FORM COMPLAINT**


Upon notice of counsel that Plaintiff, Leonore Jordan, is deceased, and this matter having come before the Court on consent of all parties, and for good cause,

It is hereby ORDERED as follows on this the 26th day of May 2017:


