This matter having come before the Court upon the application of Plaintiffs, the Defendants having consented to same and the Court having reviewed the matter,


IT IS ON THIS 23<sup>rd</sup> day of MARCH, 2021,

**ORDERED THAT:**

1. For the two trial cases (*Carl v. Johnson & Johnson, et al*, Docket No. ATL-L-6546-14 and *Balderrama v. Johnson & Johnson, et al.*, Docket No.: ~~ATL-L-6540~~  
*ATL-L-6540-14*), the parties shall proceed as follows:
  - a. Updated Plaintiff's Fact Sheets and medical authorizations to be provided by April 1, 2021.
  - b. Amendments to complaints shall be filed by April 8, 2021; answers to the amended complaints shall be filed by April 29, 2021
  - c. The depositions of case specific fact witnesses and the plaintiffs shall be completed by July 1, 2021.
  - c. Plaintiffs' Expert Reports shall be due August 27, 2021.
  - d. Defendants' Expert Reports shall be due October 29, 2021.
  - e. Expert Depositions completed by December 16, 2021.
  - f. All Dispositive Motions filed by January 14, 2022.
  - g. All Responsive Briefs filed by February 11, 2022.
  - h. All reply briefs filed by February 25, 2022. .
2. Trial date(s) shall be assigned at a later date for *Carl v. Johnson & Johnson, et al*, Docket No. ATL-L-6546-14 and *Balderrama v. Johnson & Johnson, et*
